## Events:

Open, A, B, C and D grade. There will be Men's Singles, Women's Singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Doubles and Mixed Doubles for each of the above grades if there are enough entries. Grades may be combined pending the number of entries. Events will be conducted in round robin or elimination format depending on the number of entries.

## Conditions of Entry

All players submitting entries for the tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions under which the tournament events are to be conducted. The organisers will NOT be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any player or official arising from their participation in this Tournament. Any costs incurred for medical treatment and/or hospitalisation shall be borne by the Member Association of the player/official concerned.

## Rules & Regulations

- Regulations:**  
The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Laws of Badminton adopted by the Badminton World Federation (BWF).
- Entries:**  
All players must be registered members of a body affiliated with NSWBA, SBA, Hunter BA, ACTBA or Inter-state associations and must be in good standing with their respective Member Association.
- Entries Close:**  
Entries close with Badminton NSW on Thursday June 12<sup>th</sup> 2014. Payment must be submitted with the entry. Please make all cheques and money orders to "NSW Badminton Association" or direct deposit/electronic funds transfer to **National Australia Bank BSB 082135 Account number 02927 5745**
- Minimum Entry:**  
Grades may be combined pending the number of entries.
- Seeding:**  
The tournament seeding will use the Badminton Australia ranking database.
- Draws:**  
The draws will be conducted by Badminton NSW on Sunday June 15<sup>th</sup> 2014.

Enquiries regarding starting times of matches are the responsibility of entrants. The timetable for the event is on this Entry Form. The Referee has the power to disqualify any player not available to play at the scheduled time. Any alterations made to the competition schedule due to unforeseen circumstances will be announced by the Referee.

- Scoring System:**  
The scoring system used will be in accordance with BWF regulations. Any alterations to the scoring system due to time restriction will be announced by the Referee.
- Withdrawals:**  
Notification of withdrawal(s) with reason must be given immediately to Badminton NSW by mobile phone or email and must be supported by a medical certificate. The organisers may require documentary evidence to support withdrawals for any other reason. If withdrawal arises after players have arrived at the venue, notification of withdrawal accompanied by supporting documentation must be made **IN PERSON** to the Referee or Deputy Referee.
- Shuttles:**  
Challenge I shuttles will be used in the tournament.

## Anti-Doping Information

Badminton players in this tournament may be subject to In - Competition drug testing. Badminton players, coaches, officials and administrators of this tournament are subject to the Badminton Australia Anti-Doping Policy which has been endorsed by each State/Territory Association.
